from his earliest work on personal identity to his last on the value of truthfulness the ideas and arguments of bernard williams in the metaphysics of personhood in the history of philosophy but especially in ethics and moral psychology have proved sometimes controversial often influential and always worth studying this book provides a comprehensive account of williams s many significant contributions to contemporary philosophy topics include personal identity various critiques of moral theory practical reasoning and moral motivation truth and objectivity and the relevance of ancient greece to modern life it not only positions williams among these important philosophical topics but also with regard to the views of other

philosophers including prominent forerunners such as hume and nietzsche and contemporary thinkers such as nagel mcdowell macintyre and taylor the fragmentary nature of williams s work is addressed and recurring themes and connections within his work are brought to light

in this book bernard williams delivers a sustained indictment of moral theory from kant onward his goal is nothing less than to reorient ethics toward the individual he deals with the most thorny questions in contemporary philosophy and offers new ideas about issues such as relativism objectivity and the possibility of ethical knowledge

bernard williams 1929 2003 is one of the most influential philosophers of the past 100 years with work ranging from meta ethics to philosophy of mind to reflections on pop culture williams wrote with a deep sensitivity to the limitations in our knowledge and an optimistic outlook on the prospects that we have nonetheless for social and moral progress if williams was right we still have much to learn from the classical world and much of the responsibility that intellectuals have relates to the need to interpret and apply that knowledge but williams was not stuck in the past and he did not advocate a rejection of science or modernity instead williams argued that there is often more knowledge around us than we realize and more opportunity than we realize for refinements in our basic ideas about persons ethics and politics this anthology showcases some of the best and most recent work from scholars working through some of the problems that williams identified as williams might have expected there is a great deal of disagreement on selected points and even on the particular approach used but in their commitment to a reflective and always somewhat skeptical outlook the authors here continue a tradition that williams felt was vital

this volume provides a systematic overview and comprehensive assessment of bernard williams s contribution to moral philosophy a field in which

williams was one of the most influential of contemporary philosophers the seven essays which were specially commissioned for this volume examine his work on moral objectivity the nature of practical reason moral emotion the critique of the morality system williams s assessment of the ethical thought of the ancient world and his later adoption of nietzsche s method of genealogy

ethics and the limits of philosophy is widely acknowledged to be bernard williams most important book and a contemporary classic of moral philosophy delivering a sustained critique of moral theory from kant onward williams reorients ethical theory towards truth truthfulness and the meaning of an individual life he explores and reflects on the thorniest problems in contemporary philosophy and offers new ideas about central issues such as relativism objectivity and the possibility of ethical knowledge this edition includes a new commentary on the text by a w moore st hugh s college oxford by the time of his death in 2003 bernard williams was one of the greatest philosophers of his generation he taught at the universities of cambridge berkeley and oxford he is the author of morality utilitarianism for and against descartes the project of pure enquiry and truth and truthfulness

a first rate introduction to a contemporary thinker of outstanding scope and real importance times literary supplement an excellent introductory survey which combines brevity lucidity and adequate documentation with critical reflection meynell has put us in a much better position to appraise one of the genuinely creative thinkers of the philosophical theology of our time the churchman a lively general introduction to a range of lonergan s thinking which succeeds in presenting it in a reasonably straightforward terms with some indication of its significance in the light of better known ideas than it contains itself very useful indeed religious studies

descartes has often been called the father of modern philosophy his attempts to find foundations for knowledge and to reconcile the existence of the soul with the emerging science of his time are among the most influential and widely studied in the history of philosophy this is a classic and challenging introduction to descartes by one of the most distinguished modern philosophers bernard williams not only analyzes descartes project of founding knowledge on certainty but uncovers the philosophical motives for his search with acute insight he demonstrates how descartes meditations are not merely a description but the very enactment of philosophical thought and discovery williams covers all of the key areas of descartes thought including god the will the possibility of knowledge and the mind and its place in nature he also makes profound contributions to the theory of knowledge metaphysics and philosophy generally with a new foreword by john cottingham

this collection of historical essays range from the 6th century bc to the 20th century ad from homer to collingwood by way of socrates plato and

aristotle descartes hume and nietzsche this is the history of philosophy written philosophically insights into the past counteract blind acceptance of present assumptions

this is a collection of essays in metaphysics ethics and related branches of philosophy by bernard williams one of the greatest philosophers of the 20th century most essays were previously unpublished or relatively inaccessible all of them are written with his distinctive rigour imagination and depth

bernard williams is one of the most influential figures in recent ethical theory where he has set a considerable part of the current agenda in this collection a distinguished international team of philosophers who have been stimulated by williams work give new responses to it the topics covered include equality consistency comparisons between science and ethics integrity moral reasons the moral system and moral knowledge williams himself then provides a substantial reply which in turn shows both the current directions of his own thought and also his present view of his earlier work such as that on utilitarianism

more than being a volume about the philosophy of bernard harrison this volume is about how harrison conceptualizes the creation of the human world one might be tempted to classify harrison as a major voice in many diverse discussions philosophy of literature philosophy of language philosophy of mind color studies epistemology metaphysics moral philosophy philosophy of culture wittgenstein antisemitism and more without recognizing a unifying strand that ties them together nothing could be farther from the truth harrison contests and destabilizes a persistent and misleading alignment of culture with subjectivity whether found in unexamined distinctions between nature and culture or appearance and reality his general aim has been to undermine the belief that human culture deals in smoke and mirrors and that the only realities are those of extra human nature he emphasizes the paraxial foundation of meaning and argues that the creative inventions of language and culture are as real as any extra linguistic reality while granting the existence of extra human reality he holds it to be in itself conceptually unorganised but nevertheless cognitively accessible by way of sense perception and physical manipulation this volume offers new critical essays that examine harrison s corpus written by distinguished voices in philosophy and literary studies it bridges many of the abysses of conflicting opinion opened by the culture wars of the past half century importantly it includes an opening essay by harrison that elucidates the unifying strand running through his variegated philosophical writings and concludes with a chapter in which he replies to and reflects on the other critical essays herein
